Please return your registration form with payment as soon as possible, but before 28 February 2008.

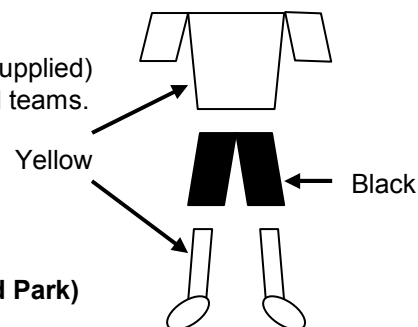

## Grading

All junior players are graded according to age.

ie; If you are born in 2001 or later you will be in the 7<sup>th</sup> grade Player Development Programme (PDP), 2000 = 8<sup>th</sup> grade, 1999 = 9<sup>th</sup> grade, 1998 = 10<sup>th</sup> grade, 1997 = 11<sup>th</sup> grade, 1996 = 12<sup>th</sup> grade, 1995 = 13<sup>th</sup> grade.

Girls may play down one age group. eg; born 1996 = 12<sup>th</sup> grade but may **choose** to play 11<sup>th</sup> grade.

Girls please ensure that you enter the grade that you want to play in the 2008 season on the enrolment form.

All girls will be placed in the lower age grade unless indicated otherwise on the enrolment form

## Season dates

PDP, 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> grades start on **Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> April 2008** (No games Saturday 26 April, 12 July)

11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup> and 13<sup>th</sup> grades start on **Saturday 5<sup>th</sup> April 2008** - (No games Saturday 26 April, 12 July)

## Team trials

Trials will be held for the 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup> + 13<sup>th</sup> grades to select the division one teams.

All enrolled players are eligible to trial, but it is not compulsory to trial.
